### ITINERARY

#### DAY 1: USA

Depart U.S. from Boston airport on overnight flight. Meals will be served on board.

#### DAY 2: TEL AVIV

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport where group will be met by tour guide. Transfer by motorcoach to hotel for dinner and overnight. (D)

#### DAY 3: MT. TABOR / NAZARETH AND CANA

Today, we will drive to Mt. Tabor. Visit Mount Tabor with a spectacular view of upper Galilee, where Jesus transfigured in the presence of Peter, James and John, and upon which stands the **Church of Transfiguration**. Continue to **Nazareth**, visit the **Basilica of the Annunciation** and view the **Blessed Cave**, where **Angel Gabriel** appeared to Mary. View **Mary and Joseph's House** and **carpentry shop** where Jesus spent 30 years of his life. Visit **Cana** where Jesus performed his first miracle. Dinner and overnight in Galilee. (B,D)

#### DAY 4: SEA OF GALILEE / BOAT RIDE / CAPERNAUM / TABGHA

After breakfast, drive to **Capernaum**, the town of Jesus which is the center of his ministry where he performed many miracles. Visit the **House of St. Peter** and the ruins of the ancient Synagogue where Jesus preached. Stop at **Tabgha**, the Primacy of St. Peter and visit the **Church of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes**, the site of the multiplication miracle, and the **Mt. of Beatitudes**. **Boat ride** on the **Sea of Galilee**. Dinner and overnight in Galilee. (B,D)

#### DAY 5: GALILEE / JORDAN RIVER / BETHLEHEM / JERUSALEM

After breakfast visit Jordan River where Jesus was baptized. Continue to Bethlehem and visit the **Church of Nativity in Bethlehem** where Jesus was born. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

#### DAY 6: JERUSALEM

After breakfast, join a full day tour of Jerusalem. Visit **Mount of Olives**, walk down the Road of Palm Sunday to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus endured his Agony. Continue to **Kidron Valley** and **Mount Zion**. Visit the **chapel of the Ascension**, from which Jesus returned to his Father. Visit the old city of Jerusalem. Follow the **Stations of the Cross** along the **Via Dolorosa to the Holy Sepulchre**. See the Christian, Armenian Quarters and the Wailing Wall. Visit the **Upper Room** where Jesus instituted the Eucharist & the Priesthood. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

#### DAY 7: JERUSALEM (Optional – Dead Sea & Masada)

Today is at your leisure in Jerusalem or you can join an **OPTIONAL** full day tour to the Dead Sea and Masada (approximate cost: \$100). Depart Jerusalem and descend on the winding road through the **Judean Desert** to the **Dead Sea**, the lowest spot on earth, 400 meters below sea level. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea via **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, to **Masada**. Here the Zealots withstood the Roman forces for 3 years, 70-73 AD. Ascend by cable car to the summit of this mountaintop fortress, and visit **Herod's Palaces**, the baths, and synagogue. After descending by cable car, enjoy the experience of a "**swim**" in the **Dead Sea**. Return to Jerusalem for Farewell dinner and overnight. (B,D)

#### DAY 8: ISRAEL / U.S.A.

Depart for flight to U.S., arriving the same day. (B)

**Prices includes the following:** Round-trip airfare from Boston Airport, group airport-hotel transfers in Israel, hotel taxes, full Israeli breakfast (in Israel) and dinner daily, accommodations in 3 star hotels with private bathrooms, sightseeing as indicated in itinerary including all entrance fees, tour guide / escort, private air-conditioned motorcoach transportation, and portage (1 piece) at the hotels.

#### DAY 8: JERUSALEM / ROME

Depart Ben Gurion Airport for flight to Rome. Upon arrival in the "Eternal City" the group will be met by their tour guide and escorted to the hotel. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (B,D)

#### DAY 9: ROME

Sightseeing of Rome including the Catacombs, Capitoline Hill, the Forum, Colosseum, Arch of Constantine, Circus Maximus, Pantheon, Old Appian Way, Palazzo Venezia. Visit to three of the four Major Basilicas: St. Mary Major, St. John Lateran, and St. Paul Outside the Walls. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (B,D)

#### DAY 10: ROME (ASSISI EXCURSION)

Depart early morning for the town of St. Francis, Assisi. A tour will include visits to the Basilica of St. Francis (view the exquisite artwork of Giotto), Convent of St. Clare, and Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels with Portiuncula chapel. Afternoon free to explore Assisi. Return to Rome for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

#### DAY 11: ROME (Papal Audience)

Attendance at the Holy Father's Audience when the Holy Father is in Italy. Visit St. Peter's Basilica, the Vatican Museum and Sistine Chapel. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (B,D)

#### DAY 12: ROME / U.S.A.

Depart for flight to U.S., arriving the same day. (B)

### **PAYMENT INFORMATION:**

(Deposits, Second payments, and Final payments)

\*A deposit of \$489 or \$539 is required no later than 95 days prior to departure to secure a reservation. There is no guarantee we can obtain airline seats for late bookings. This payment includes the cost (NON-REFUNDABLE) of optional TRIP MATE trip cancellation protection and travel insurance (\$189 for a tour that costs \$3,000 or under, and \$239 for a tour that costs \$3001 and up), and \$300 deposit for the tour. This coverage is highly recommended by The Catholic Tour Company. If you wish to decline this insurance, you must do so in writing and deduct \$189 or the applicable amount from your deposit payment. FULL payment is due no later than 65 days prior to departure. Late payments can be assessed a \$100 late fee. Reservations may be cancelled and we reserve the right to levy full cancellation charges as set forth in these conditions if full payment is not received 65 days prior to the departure date of the tour. In the event of billing error, we reserve the right to reinvoice with correct pricing. Final documents and tickets will be issued after final payment has been processed, and normally will be sent 1 – 2 weeks prior to departure.

**General:** \*Deposit, including appropriate travel insurance premium, is necessary to secure a reservation.

\*For late bookings (within 60 days of departure), full payment is due immediately by bank check or money order. No reservations will be accepted 45 days or less before departure.

\*Late bookings (within 60 days of departure) are subject to a \$100.00 late fee plus any increase in quoted airfare.

\*All payments, except late bookings, can be made by personal check, bank check or money order. Visa, MasterCard and Discover will be accepted for all payments except late bookings. Credit cards will not be accepted for reservations made by travel agents.

\* No personal checks or credit cards will be accepted with payments 45 days or less before departure date. Only money orders or cashier's checks will be accepted.

### **CANCELLATION INFORMATION:**

All Cancellations must be in writing to us and must be signed by the person who made the original reservation. Cancellations are only effective from the day they are actually received by The Catholic Tour Company. US Postmark prevails. No refunds are issued for cancellations received after the departure date of the tour. Penalties will apply. If you cancel your tour, cancellation fees and penalties will be deducted from your refund. Cancellation fees do apply to deposit checks. Cancellation fees apply to each person.

61 or more days . . . . \$250

31-60 days . . . . . 50% of tour cost

15-30 days . . . . . 75% of tour cost

Less than 15 days . . . . 100% of tour cost. No refund.

There may be additional airline, cruise line and land operator penalties applicable. Special events and Custom Groups: Based on contract. There will be a \$100 administrative rebooking fee and a \$100 late booking fee (for booking within 60 days of departure).

**ROOMS:** Prices are based on double occupancy. Single rooms are available at a supplementary cost as stated on individual itineraries. A limited number of single rooms are available. On those very rare occasions when we are not able to get a roommate for you, you will be required to pay the single supplement. We will attempt to give sufficient prior notice to any room changes regarding double occupancy versus single supplement. Triple rooms may not be available in all countries.

**TAXES:** Tour price includes all government taxes and fees associated with the airfare. Please see individual itineraries for prices, which may vary. **Departure taxes and fuel surcharge may increase subsequent to the printing of the brochure or flyer** up until the time the group seats are purchased, typically 45 days prior to departure.

**TIPPING:** The price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the Tour Escort and Motor Coach Driver approximately €4 / \$5 and €2 / \$3 per person, respectively, per day to each; local step-on guides 1-2 Euros per day. **Hotel tips are not included in tours to the Middle East or on some other**

**tours. Please refer to the individual itinerary.**

**SIGHTSEEING & ITINERARIES:** Sightseeing is included as per the itinerary and is under the direction of licensed local guides where required. During holidays some sights such as museums may be closed or unavailable for visits. The Catholic Tour Company reserves the right to vary the sequence of sightseeing and / or to re-route the order of cities should circumstances demand it. In either case, the itinerary content will be maintained, however, the order may change.

**Considerable amount of walking may be necessary while sightseeing.** Please understand that not all museums and attractions are open every day of the year. The Papal Audience takes place on Wednesdays, and the Papal Blessing is on Sundays. Both are only available in accordance with His Holiness' schedule, and may not take place when He is out of the country. There are no refunds for any unused portion of these excursions. Optional side trips and optional extensions need a minimum number of pilgrims to operate.

**MEDICAL CONDITION:** We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Handicapped participants who require special assistance **must** be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the handicapped participants' well being. The Catholic Tour Company is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior, during or after the tour.

**BAGGAGE:** The passenger is allowed to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

**AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH:** Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups flying together for the entire itinerary. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. **SEAT ASSIGNMENT:** There is no advance seat selection for tour departures. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companion. Three hours advance arrival to departing airport is required.
